

**ANALYSIS OF THE SURVEY OF HIGHER EDUCATION STUDENTS
OF THE EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM “PSYCHOLOGY”
(FIRST – BACHELOR’S LEVEL)
OF THE ODESA INSTITUTE of PJSC “HEI ‘MAUP’”**

Date of the survey: February 2025

Number of respondents: 188 persons

Main survey questions and summarized responses:

1. Are you satisfied with the quality of teaching of the disciplines?

- Yes – 75%
- Partially – 23%
- No – 2%

2. Does the education meet your expectations regarding the chosen specialty?

- Yes – 73%
- Partially – 24%
- No – 3%

3. How do you assess the adequacy of hours allocated for lectures/practical classes?

- Sufficient – 71%
- Would like more practical classes – 29%
- Insufficient – 0%

4. Is the assessment system clear and objective?

- Yes – 87%
- Not always – 11%
- No – 2%

5. Do you feel respect and support from the teaching staff?

- Always – 82%
- Sometimes – 18%
- No – 0%

6. Is the educational environment comfortable and safe?

- Yes – 73%
- There are some difficulties – 24%
- No – 3%

7. Do you participate in scientific, creative, or volunteer activities?

- Yes – 63%
- Sometimes – 27%
- No – 10%

8. Would you like to undertake professional practice or internship in your field?

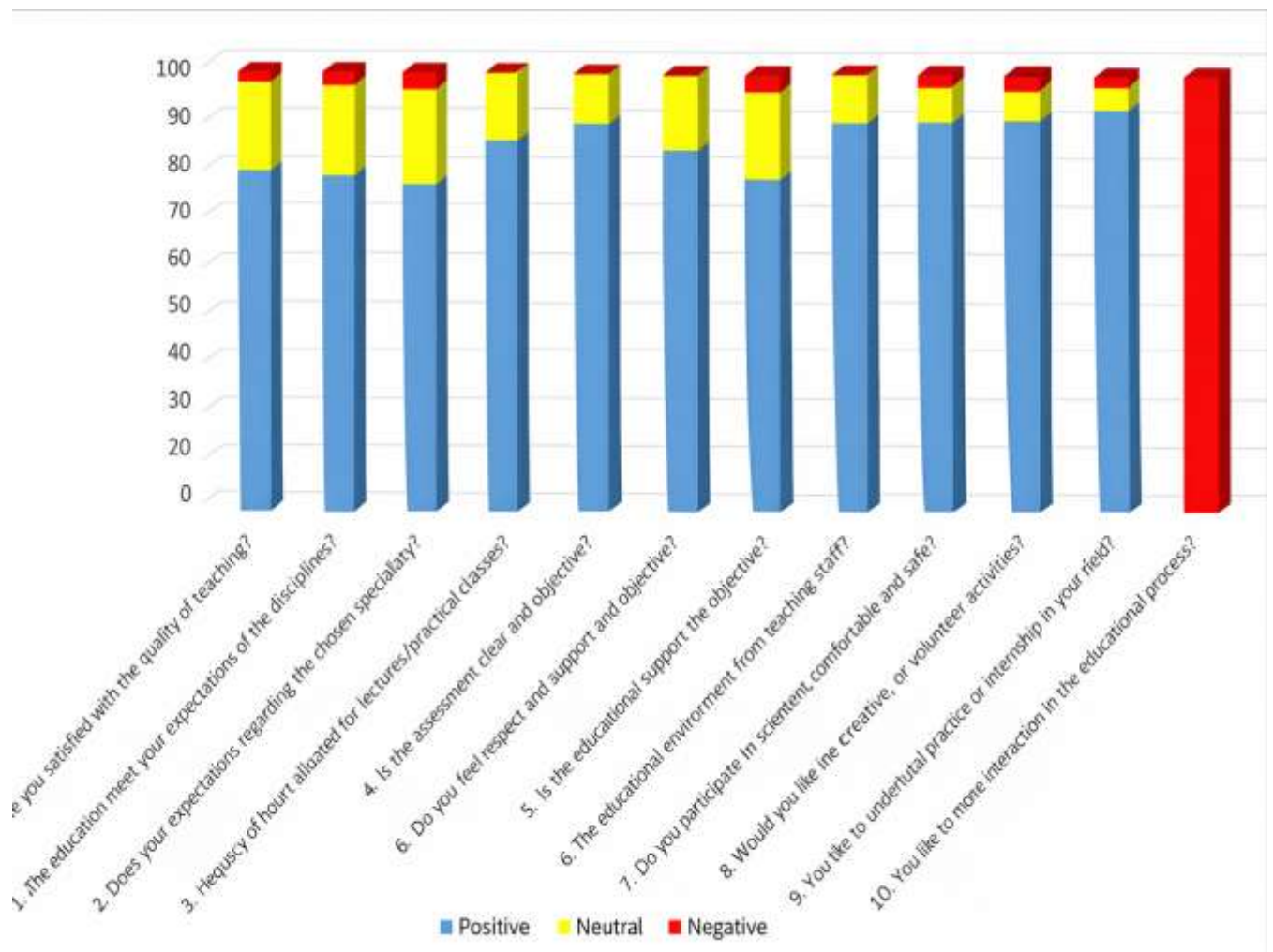
- Yes – 97%

- No – 4%

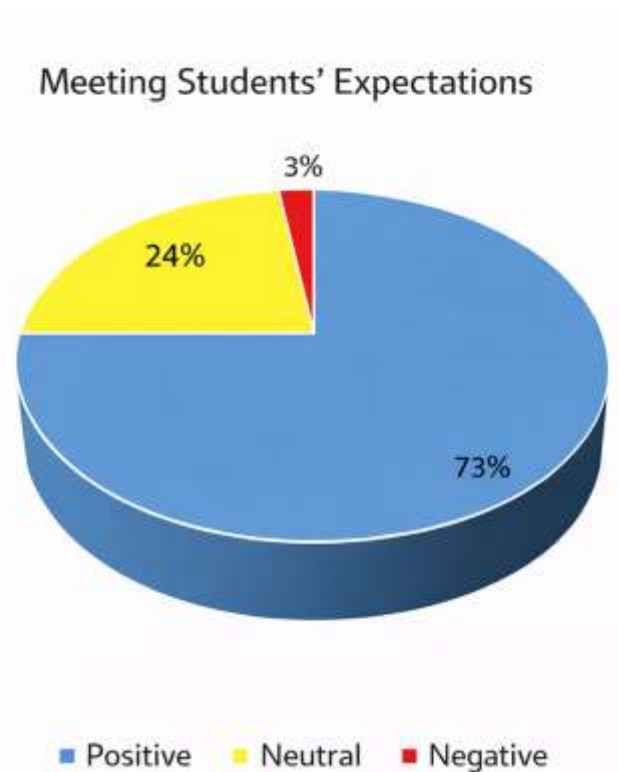
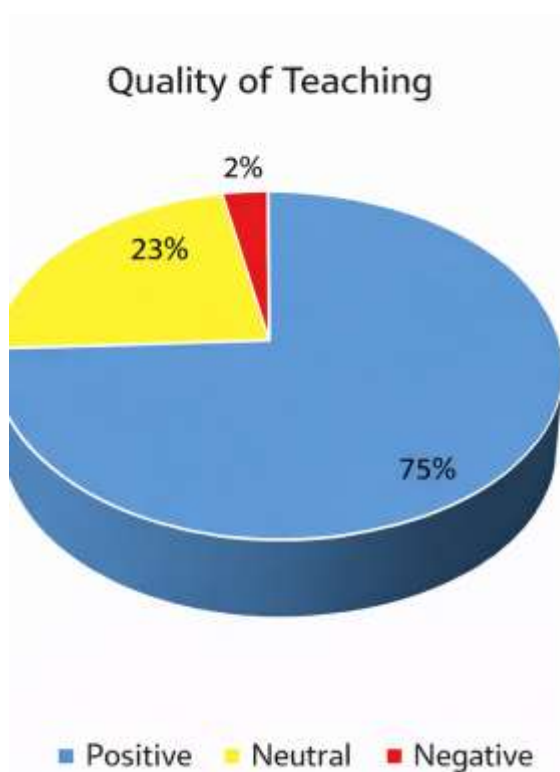
10. Are there any manifestations of corruption in the educational process?

- No – 100%

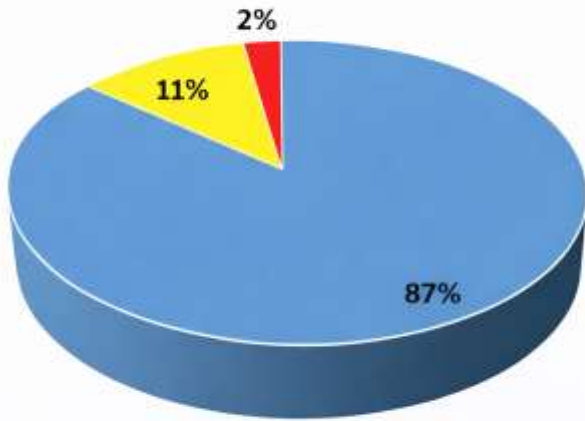


General Conclusions Based on the Survey Results:

- The teaching staff received a high evaluation: 75% of respondents are satisfied with the quality of teaching, 87% consider the assessment system to be objective, and 82% noted respect and support from instructors.
- The educational process leaves a positive overall impression on most students: over 73% believe that their studies meet their expectations.
- Practical training remains a key priority: 97% of students express a desire to undertake internships, and 87% would like more interaction with practicing psychologists.
- No manifestations of corruption were identified: 100% of students reported no cases of corruption.
- The educational environment was assessed positively: 73% of respondents feel comfortable and safe.
- Scientific and civic engagement among respondents stands at 63%, indicating a satisfactory but not yet fully realized level of participation. This points to existing potential for further development and strengthening of extracurricular and academic activities.

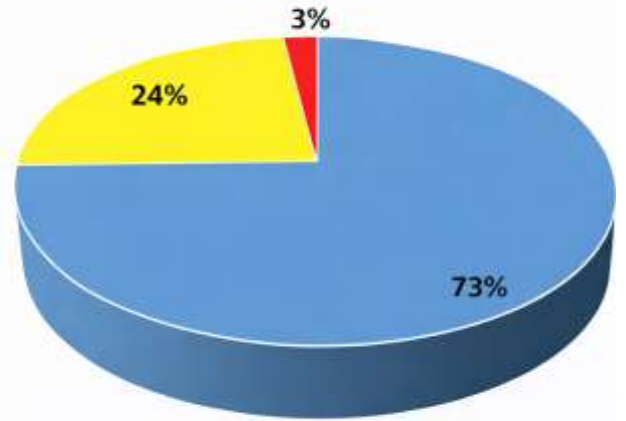


Assesment System



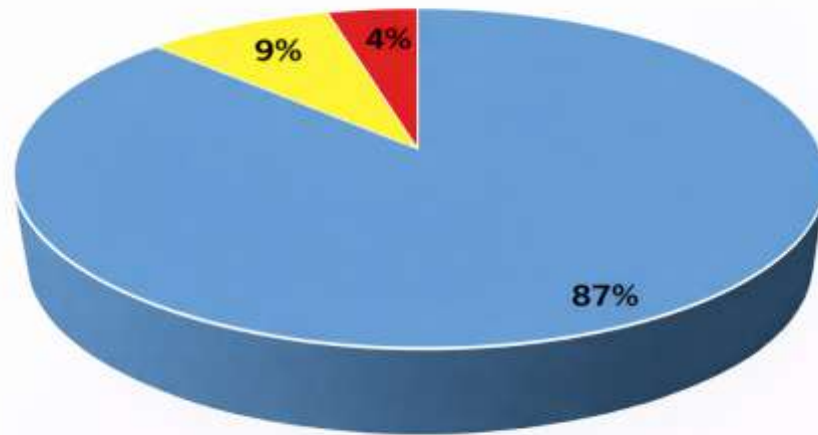
■ Positive ■ Neutral ■ Negative
